

OFFICIAL CALL TO 2018 MFRW FALL CONVENTION

In accordance with the Bylaws of the Maryland Federation of Republican Women (MFRW), Article XII, Section 2, I hereby call the MFRW Fall Convention (and Fall Board of Directors Meeting) to be held at the Holiday Inn Solomons Conference Center and Marina in Solomons, MD (Calvert County) on November 16 -17, 2018. Friday Registration opens at 1:30PM. Saturday Registration opens at 7:30AM.

The theme for this year's Fall Convention is "Celebrating our Successes!" Fingers-crossed, we will have many electoral successes to celebrate.
